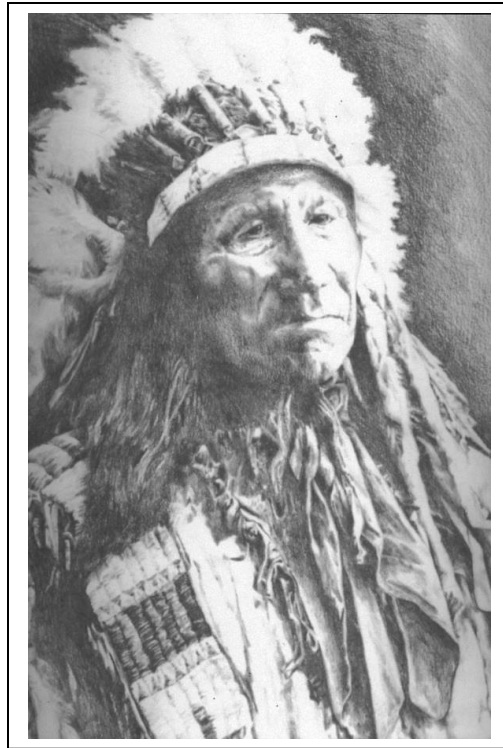


IMPROVE YOUR DRAWINGS WITH LIGHT AND SHADOW

What is the difference between these 2 drawings??



Well....the one on the left is basically a line drawing. On the right we find that same drawing enhanced with shading, light and shadow.

You've got to be able to "draw" correctly first....getting your proportions and line placement correct.
